

This project focuses on the communities of the middle and lower Ouse Valley in East Sussex, broadly outlined on the map below. The project area follows the river valley downstream from the village of **Barcombe**, through **Lewes** (the county town of East Sussex and largest town in a UK National Park) and the **villages of the lower Ouse Valley**, to the large coastal communities (“the Havens”) adjacent to the mouth of the river Ouse: **Seaford**, **Peacehaven** and the Channel port at **Newhaven**.
